Picnics in the Park

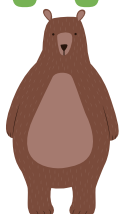

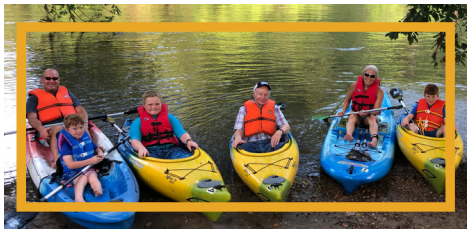



Star gazing!

AUG 12TH | CEDAR RIVER GREENBELT TRAIL

One of the BEST stargazing spots in Mitchell County is at the shelter along our Cedar River Greenbelt Trail. After a short (10 min/.4mi) walk down the trail, a large grassy area welcomes stargazers for an amazing view of the night sky during the height of the Perseid Meteor Shower.

Grab something comfortable to sit on (blanket or camp chair), a water bottle, bug spray, and a head lamp or flashlight - then just sit back and enjoy the celestial show! Comfortable walking shoes and a sweatshirt or light jacket are also recommended (depending on the weather).

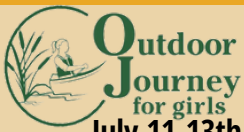
While we wait for dark, stargazers will enjoy a program on night sky viewing, stars, and constellations. Binoculars, star charts, and constellation guides will be provided for use. Supplies to build your own micro-meteor collector, and other fun star activities will also be available.

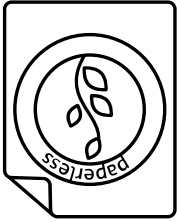
